Before installation

- 1. Before installation, check local laws and regulations, as well as those of any regions your vehicle may travel to, to ensure the auxiliary lights comply with all requirements.
- 2. Carefully read all installation instructions prior to beginning.
- 3. Verify that the dimensions and weight of the lamps and devices are suitable for your vehicle, see figure 01.
- 4. Unpack the product and check that the lamp housing or lens is not damaged when removing it from the packaging.
- 5. Ensure the power is turned off during installation.
- 6. A small amount of internal moisture may occur but will be expelled through the vent after 2-4 operating cycles.
- 7. Operating Voltage: 10-32V DC.

Mounting

- 1. Drill 8.5 mm holes on the surface where you intend to install the light for screw placement.
- 2. Use the bolt to fasten the lamp, add the locking washer, and tighten the bolt securely.
- 3. Connect black cable to ground (-).
- 4. Connect red cable to positive (+).
- 5. To synchronice multiple units (max 10 pcs) connect the white cables together, and keep connected otherwise units will fall out of sync.
- 6. To switch between day and night mode, apply the white cables to positive (+) for 1 second, and then release.

Figure 01. shows multi mounting options: side bracket and bottom bracket.

Wiring connections & Functions

Black: Ground, Red: Flood light, +
Yellow: R65 function by day, +
White: Day/night mode/sync, +
Blue: Red position light on reflector, +

Wiring harness: 40A relay, 30A fuse.
